

## **50th ISRAEL ANNUAL CONFERENCE ON AEROSPACE SCIENCES**

### **Text Based Abstract, Presenter's CV and Final Manuscript Preparation Instructions and Formats**

This document details the format and content of the text based abstract, presenter's CV and the final manuscript of papers accepted for presentation at the 50th Israel Annual Conference on Aerospace Sciences. These three items must be submitted through the conference papers site by January 28, 2010.

#### **Text Based Abstract**

The text based abstract, for inclusion in the Book of Abstracts of the conference, should be written in paragraph mode and limited to 500 words. Do not include the title or author information. Do not include graphics, figures, or mathematical equations. Please note that this may be a different, somewhat more detailed abstract than what is included in your final manuscript (see below). The abstract must be copied into the Abstract area of the final submission window/form by January 28, 2010. Any abstract entered after that date will not appear in the Book of Abstracts.

#### **Presenter's CV**

In the appropriate area of the final submission window/form, please type in a short CV of the person presenting the paper at the conference. If the presenter is not the corresponding author of the paper (corresponding author is the person who submitted the paper to the conference site), please include the presenter's name on the first line of the CV. This information will be used by the session chair to introduce the speaker before the talk, and therefore should only be a few sentences.

## **FINAL PAPER FORMAT (PDF FILE) Formatting**

1. Please use 12 pt Times New Roman (or LaTeX equivalent) fonts.
2. The text should be in one column and single-spaced.
3. All margins – 2.54 cm.
4. Page numbers to appear at the bottom of the page and centered.
5. Justify left and right margins.
6. Papers are limited to 40 pages (including figures).
7. Reference numbers in body of the paper in square brackets.

### **Page Layout HEADINGS**

Title of the paper in **bold CAPITAL LETTERS** centered across the page

Author(s)

Address in upper and lower case letters

### **ABSTRACT**

100 to 200 words paragraph at the beginning of the paper. This should be a summary, complete in itself (no numerical references). Readers should not have to read the paper to understand the abstract.

Section headings in **bold CAPITAL LETTERS** and centered **Subheadings bold** and placed flush against the left hand margin **Sub-subheadings bold** and indented

**EQUATION NUMBERS** Flush against the right-hand margin. (1)

### **SYMBOLS & ABBREVIATIONS**

Use only standard symbols and abbreviations in text and illustrations.

### **REFERENCES**

List and number all bibliographical references at the end of the paper.
